Several Cancers Presumptive for Service-Connection

On January 8, 2025, the VA announced it is making acute chronic leukemias, multiple myelomas, myelodysplastic syndromes, myelofibrosis, urinary bladder, ureter, and related genitourinary cancers presumptive for service-connection. This step lowers the burden of proof for veterans who served for:

Gulf War Veterans- Veterans who served in Somalia or the Southwest Asia theater which includes, Iraq, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, the neutral zone between Iraq and Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Qatar, the UAE, Oman, Gulf of Aden, Gulf of Oman, Persian Gulf, Arabian Sea and the airspace above these locations on or after Aug. 2, 1990.

Post 9-11 Veterans- Veterans who served in Afghanistan, Iraq, Djibouti, Egypt, Jorda, Lebanon, Syria, Yemen, or Uzbekistan, including the Karshi-Khanabad (k2) base and the airspace above these locations on or after Sept 11, 2001, during the Gulf War.

The VA lowers life insurance premiums

On Dec 12, 2024, the VA announced that more than 3 million veterans, service members, and spouses who receive life insurance with VA's programs will receive a discount on the premiums starting in the spring of 2025.

Veterans- Members could see their rates discounted between 2%-17% depending on age.

Service Members- Includes active duty, Reserve and National Guard members.

Spouses - Spouses covered under FSGLI will see a decrease between 11%-22% depending on age.

Expansion of Veterans Legacy Memorial (VLM)

On Jan. 16, 2025, the VA expanded VLM- the nation's largest digital platform dedicated to the memory of Veterans and service members-to allow their own stories before they pass away. The new "Your Story, Your Legacy" feature will allow Veterans who have been approved for VA's pre-need eligibility determination for burial in a VA cemetery, to log into the secure website where they can submit images, autobiographies, military and life milestones and historical documents.
