House Passes Automatic COLA increase. The Veterans Compensation Cost-of-Living-Adjustment Act of 2021 was Passed. This bill would ensure that whenever there is a cost-of-living-increase in benefits for Social Security recipients, the VA would increase by the same percentage the amounts payable for veterans disability.

The VA has extended Gulf War Illness Presumptive issues due to the recent war in Iraq. The VA said the reason for this is they do not know what effect these Iraq Veterans may have from being in the litter box. There are 10 presumptive illnesses listed, so if you were in the Gulf War or in Iraq anytime and you are having any unexplained illnesses, come and talk to myself or Scott Sutherland. Agent orange veterans and blue water navy includes Thailand and Guam. There are 24 presumptive issues and should you have any unexplained illnesses, please talk to me or Scott.
