You will never know unless you try, even if you get a zero rating, that is still a good rating. You can get treatment and it is noted and you can always appeal it or do a claim later on down the road.

Spouses who lose their veteran can always come and see me and Scott. If the veteran passed away from a service connected disability, we can claim DIC and if they don't qualify for that, we can always claim Widows Pension.

### **QUARTERMASTER**

The post finances remain in stable condition but our total net worth has dropped since the last newsletter. This drop was expected due to several large expenditures that did not come due until a few days ago. The post is still in good shape. Time to vent just a little on lack of volunteers assisting with meals. Every time we cancel a meal the post and the canteen loose revenue. Income from meals is not great but does provide additional operating income. The looser on cancelled meals is the canteen. NO FOOD no drink equals lost income. The post has approximately 1200 members between the VFW and the Auxiliary, YET, we cannot find enough volunteers to handle three meals per week that need help. We actually have four meals with the Auxiliary providing individuals for the meal and receives the income from this meal. Why is it so hard to find 4-5 individuals to handle one meal per week with 1200 members. Just for the record, we have several individuals that provide 18-30 hours per week volunteering to keep the post operating. If a few of these volunteers decide enough is enough and no longer volunteer, the post will go down hill quickly. From your short timer QM, have a wonderful week.
