There is always someone manning the phones.

I am always here and always have time to talk. I have dealt a lot with suicides and talking people Down, so please if you need to talk, call me. My number is (904) 524-2714. This is my cell phone and always attached to my hip.

Even in the hospital I was taking care of veterans over the phone. Enough said.

The next thing is Corona Virus and COVID 19 (MEARS/SARS) are real. I spent a week in the hospital with COVID 19 SARS with bilat double pneumonia. The nurses thought they were going to lose me and at one point called in the rapid response team in because I couldn't breathe, and being the stubborn old Chief, I chased them away. They did say if I didn't improve they were going to take me to ICU and intubate me. But thanks to all of your prayers, I made it through. Still not 100%. I am living on O2 24/7 just to breathe.

The bottom line here is take care of yourself, mask up, wash your hands constantly, and practice social distancing.

On Dec. 10th, we will have our annual Bartender Appreciation Night. Please come in and show our wonderful bartenders how much we appreciate them all year long.



NATIONAL PARKS

Beginning on Veterans Day, November 11, 2020, Gold Star Families and U.S. military veterans receive free access to more than 2,000 federal recreation areas, including national parks, wildlife refuges and forests. The free access program is a way to thank America's veterans and Gold Star families for their support of our country and to encourage them to explore recreational opportunities on their public lands and waters.

For purposes of this program, a veteran is identified as an individual who has served in the U.S. Armed Forces, including the National Guard and Reserves, and is able to present one of the following forms of identification when entering a national park:

- Department of Defense Identification Card (CAC Card)
- Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- Veteran ID Card
- Veterans designation on a state-issued U.S. driver's license or identification card
